INTRODUCTION

Marc Defang Attire *

Contestants should introduce themselves by stating their name and sharing one interesting fact about themselves. For Pre-School through Kindergarten contestants, the emcee will ask for their name only, and a fun fact is not necessary. The judges will be evaluating contestants based on their natural beauty and enjoyment during the competition. Is the contestant having fun? This category will take place right after the opening number. Each contestant will have a maximum of 30 seconds for their introduction.

**Contestants in 6th grades or below, or in the extended divisions may wear pink instead of the opening production dress for introduction

FORMAL WEAR

Pageant or Prom Dress

Contestants in the first grade and above are required to wear a full-length, formal dress of their choosing. Preschool through Kindergarten contestants may wear either a short dress or a long gown. It's important to note that the judges won't be evaluating the gown itself, but rather the overall appearance, taking into account the contestant's look, how well the dress fits, and if the color suits them. There won't be any specific walking pattern assigned to the contestants, and the stage will be set up in the usual T-formation. Each contestant will have a maximum of 90 seconds on stage.

Contestants will have the opportunity to speak with the judges after their stage appearance in their formal attire. There won't be any difficult or tricky questions asked. Our judges are warm and friendly and just want to get to know the contestant better. During the interview, it will be conducted privately and in a panel format. Contestants are free to choose whether they prefer to sit or stand during this interaction.

VOLUNTEER SERVICE

Volunteer service holds great significance for our organization. Contestants were required to compile a portfolio of photographs and descriptions, which can be presented in the form of a document or a book to participate. The emphasis is placed on the content rather than the format in which the information is presented.

We are thrilled to announce that we have recently been accepted into the America Corps volunteer service program! As a result, we are planning to revamp this competition in 2024 to incorporate the presentation of the prestigious Presidential Volunteer Service Awards. Our commitment to volunteerism remains unwavering, and we recognize the invaluable contributions made by individuals who selflessly dedicate their time and efforts to serving others. We believe that by showcasing the remarkable work of our contestants, we can inspire and encourage even more individuals to engage in volunteer service.

ESSAY AWARD

Aside from your parents, who is your greatest supporter or your biggest fan? Contestants have shared with us the individuals who hold this significant role in their lives. We will be awarding one winner per grade level. Elementary and Middle School students were required to hand write their essays, while High School students were expected to type theirs and certify that the work was entirely their own. Essays were limited to a single page.

COLORING CONTEST

Participants were invited to showcase their artistic abilities by creating and designing a coloring sheet using crayons or markers. The emphasis was on encouraging contestants to unleash their creativity! They were given the freedom to cut, paste, and even add sparkles to their coloring sheet. To ensure fairness, parents were required to certify that the work was solely completed by the contestant. All coloring sheets were uploaded prior to the pageant, allowing them to be displayed on our website. In an exciting addition this year, our Teen and Miss contestants were given the opportunity to participate by completing an adult coloring sheet.

AMERICA'S MISS USS

THE PAGEANT

The immediate family members of the pageant staff are not eligible to participate in the competition. Contestants will be grouped according to their age in the Fall of the current year. It is essential for all contestants to possess outstanding moral character, as they will serve as role models for our younger queens. Additionally, our overall winners will be expected to make mandatory appearances.

JUDGES

In order to ensure fairness, we have arranged for a separate panel of judges to evaluate our interview competition, which will be taking place simultaneously with our stage competition. We strive to bring in judges from outside the state and who are not affiliated with any particular circuit. However, please note that the pageant reserves the right to replace judges in case of unforeseen circumstances, such as judges encountering accidents while traveling to Alabama, flight cancellations, or last minute cancellations. We guarantee a fair competition where all judges are highly qualified, and their decisions will be considered final.

SCORESHEETS

You can collect your scoresheets once the final group in your section has been crowned. Please do not approach the auditor or the judges' table, as it can distract the contestants who are still on stage.

FINE PRINT

The national queens will have their photos taken at 5:00 PM on Sunday, October 8. It is important for the national queens to attend various appearances such as the Photo Shoot, NY Fashion Week, and Queen Cruise, unless they have a valid reason not to attend. Additionally, we kindly request that the national queens return to crown their successor.

It is mandatory for the queens to maintain an active presence on social media. Please note that all photos taken during the event may be used for marketing purposes. We have a zero-tolerance policy for poor sportsmanship, which applies to both contestants and guests. We reserve the right to ask any guest to leave without refund and disqualify any contestant from this event or future events if they display poor sportsmanship.

When wearing their sash, queens should dress modestly and avoid tube tops, short shorts, or plunging necklines. Our national queens should primarily represent our titles during our sponsored events. While it is acceptable to take photos with other sashes and titles, we kindly request that our title is the one primarily displayed if we are sponsoring the event. This includes modeling events, queen trips, and community service projects.

Most importantly, the judges will not consider whether this is your only pageant of the year or if you compete every weekend. They will not be looking for the oldest or youngest contestant either. We simply ask that if you compete for this title, it is a title that you genuinely want to represent and that you will proudly wear the sash and crown. We are looking for Ambassadors for our system.


YOU BE THE JUDGE
